- High Angle / Horizontal Well Evaluation • Logging and Measurement While Drilling

- Magnetic Resonance Logging • Formation Testing
- Cased-hole / Production Logging

A special session, including posters, dedicated to South East Asia Regional case studies and technical specialties is planned.

Your abstract must be submitted no later than October 21, 2009 through online submission at www.spwla.org. The information contained in the abstract is the principal basis for the acceptance of the paper into the technical program. Notification of acceptance will be made in December, 2009. If accepted, the abstract will be published in the April, 2010 issue of *Petrophysics*. The paper will be scheduled for presentation at the Perth Symposium, and a complete manuscript will be required for the *Transactions* by April 9, 2010. Your abstract should contain 200 to 400 words. Avoid the use of equations, trademarks, literature references, and supplementary text. Please consult the online instructions (to be posted soon) as to whether there be any limitations as to characters that may be used (e.g., Greek symbols or special punctuation such as colons).
